The Bureau of Prisons acknowledges The Humanist Society as an ecclesiastical endorser and you as its endorsing agent for candidates from the Humanist community seeking employment with the Bureau of Prisons. The Bureau values this relationship with the ecclesiastical endorser because it recognizes the essential support the faith community provides to its chaplains and to the Bureau of Prisons in the accomplishment of our mission. Several key components highlight this integral relationship:

- a) The endorsement attests to the applicant's suitability for correctional ministry.
- b) The endorsement communicates the religious organization's support for the applicant's candidacy and spiritual edification.
- c) The endorsement provides the Bureau a clear assurance that the applicant has no present or past legal or moral barrier to congregational ministry.
- d) The endorsement provides an assurance that the applicant will facilitate inmates of all faiths with opportunities to pursue individual religious beliefs and practices.

- e) The endorsement communicates that the applicant has had a minimum two-year association with the faith community prior to endorsement.
- f) The endorsing relationship provides the Bureau of Prisons Chaplain Administrator a means to communicate religious needs and concerns of the agency with appropriate religious representatives.

We are appreciative and excited about your willingness to help our agency find, endorse, and provide spiritual support for chaplains. A significant role of the endorser is to nurture the spiritual needs of chaplains while empowering the Bureau to provide quality pastoral care to the inmates entrusted to our care.
